Updated Worship Services Information

Starting today, we will begin gathering back together in a larger group for worship at 9:00am!! This worship service will look similar to what it used to look like with a few changes and some added safety protocols to keep everyone as safe as possible. Additionally, we will continue our online worship and 2 of our worship gatherings (which still require reservations).

9:00 am Worship

Our Worship Service at 9 am will take place in the Worship Center and is for anyone and everyone (no RSVP required)

The Safety Protocols are as follows:
There will be one section of the room designated as Masks RECOMMENDED but not required, for the rest of the room masks will be required. Chairs & Rows will be spaced to allow some distancing. Singing and responsive readings will mostly happen at the end of worship to allow for maximal air safety.

We will have activities for younger children in worship, but they will worship with us for the whole time. We are hoping to begin Children's Worship in the weeks to come, but we won't start that just yet.

Worship Gatherings with Communion

Our Worship Gatherings are small groups (about 15-20 people) who gather to worship. Our first gathering on Sunday will meet at 8:00 am outside the church followed by a Worship Center Worship with masks and social distancing at 10:45 am.
