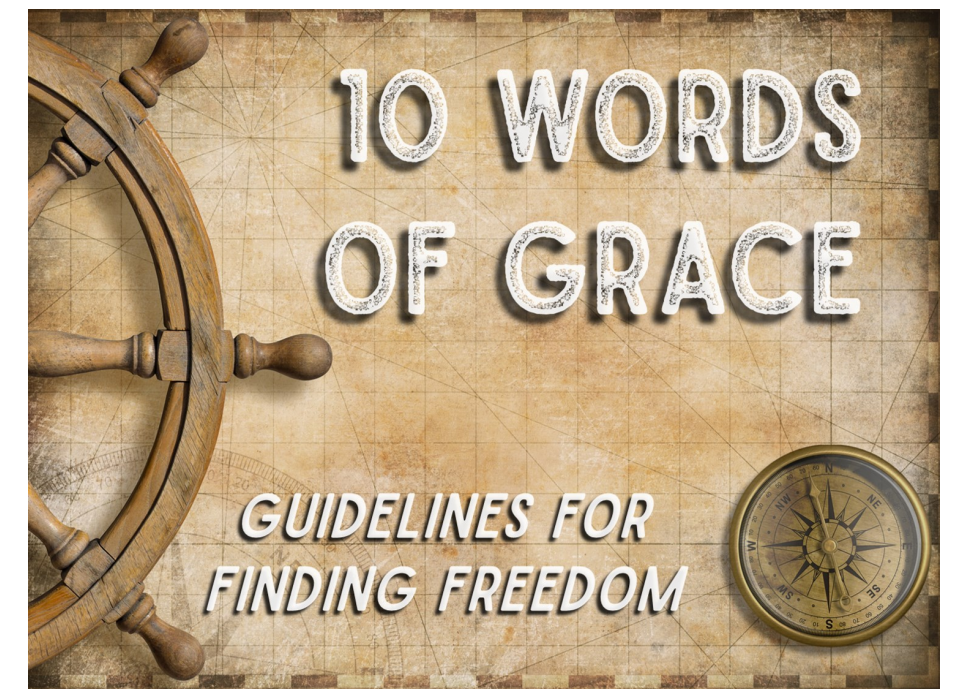
Meets every second Saturday of the month at 8 am at Feedstore BBQ. Masks are optional.
